DIRECTIONS

FROM SR78 EAST

SR 78 to I-15 North, exit El Norte Pkwy. Turn right on El Norte Pkwy continuing to East Valley Pkwy. Turn left on East Valley Pkwy. Go past Eureka Springs and turn left at the traffic light at Beven Drive. Park in open field on your right.

FROM I-15 SOUTHBOUND

Exit El Norte Parkway. Turn left (East) onto El Norte Parkway continuing to East Valley Parkway. Turn left on East Valley Parkway. Go past Eureka Springs residential area and turn left at traffic light at Beven Drive. Park in open field on your right.

FROM I-15 NORTHBOUND

Exit Via Rancho Parkway. Go north for about 6 miles. Via Rancho becomes Bear Valley Parkway. Continue until it ends at East Valley Parkway. Turn right onto East Valley Parkway. Go past Washington Ave/El Norte Pkwy and Eureka Springs residential area. Turn left at traffic light at Beven Drive. Park in open field on your right

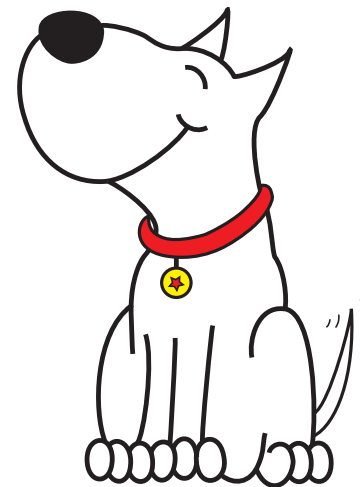

IMPORTANT!

REFUNDS

- Full entry fees will be refunded if an entry is pulled before the closing date and time of the trial or before the trial is full, whichever occurs first.
- No refund will be made for any pulled entry made after the closing date with the exception of a bitch in heat. A bitch in season may be pulled up to the Monday prior to the trial week-end and receive a full refund.
- Entry fees will NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial committee, is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly or if a trial cannot open or be completed.

CANCELLATION OF A TRIAL

SDDF reserves the right to cancel the event in extreme weather conditions or any other cause beyond the control of the Trial Committee. The well being of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance. If it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion NO REFUND OF ENTRY WILL BE MADE.

HURDLE HEIGHTS

Size Division 1: Jumps 8 INCH HURDLES, Veteran Jumps 8 inches
Shoulder height up to and including 14 inches,

Size Division 2: Jumps 14 INCH HURDLES, Veteran Jumps 8 inches
Shoulder height over 14 inches, and up to & including 20 inches

Size Division 3: Jumps 20 INCH HURDLES, Veteran Jumps 14 inches
Shoulder height over 20 inches

CRAWL SPACES

Size Division 1: Crawls 8 INCHES for (a), 12 INCHES for (b) & (c)
(a) for depth of chest up to and including 7 inches

(b) for depth of chest over 7 inches, up to & including 10 inches
(c) for depth of chest up to and including 10 inches VETERAN

Size Division 2: Crawls 12 INCHES for (a), 16 INCHES for (b) & (c)
(a) for depth of chest over 7 inches, up to & including 20 inches.

(b) for depth of chest over 10 inches, up to & including 14 inches
(c) for depth of chest over 7 inches up to and incl 10 inches VETERAN

Size Division 3: Crawls 16 INCHES for (a), 20 INCHES for (b) & (c)
(a) for depth of chest over 20 inches

(b) for depth of chest over 14 inches

(c) for depth of chest over 10 inches VETERAN

ALL depth of chest exceptions for the higher crawl space must be approved by the judge prior to judging on the day of trial.

You can enter both AGI and AGII at this trial.

You do not have to complete the requirements for AGI to enter AGII.

AGILITY I TITLE (UAGI)

Title is earned by: receiving three (3) qualifying scores at three (3) different U.K.C. Licensed Agility Trials. A qualifying score requires the successful completion of all obstacles and a score of 170 or more. All three qualifying scores may be obtained under the same Judge. Dogs may continue to be entered in this Class after having completed the requirements for the UAGI title.

AGILITY II TITLE (UAGII)

Title is earned by: receiving three (3) qualifying scores at three (3) different U.K.C. Licensed Agility Trials. A qualifying score requires the successful completion of all obstacles and a score of 170 or more. All three qualifying scores may be obtained under the same Judge. Dogs may continue to be entered in this Class after having completed the requirements for the UAGII title.

Entry in the Agility II class is open to dogs with or without the Agility I title. Although a dog may be entered in the Agility II Class before having completed the requirements for the Agility I Class, the Agility II title (UAGII) is not awarded until the dog has completed the requirements for the Agility I title (UAGI).

AGILITY CHAMPION TITLE (UACH).

Title is earned by: (A) accumulation of 100 points awarded for scores of 196 or more in the Agility IB and Agility IIB Classes; (B) at least 40 of the 100 required points must be obtained from the Agility II Class.
