

## CLASSES

AGI-A ~ Eligible Competitors

- a) Open to dogs that have not earned a UKC UAGI title.

AGI-A ~ Ineligible Competitors: The following are ineligible to compete in AGI-A

- a) Any licensed or professional dog trainer.
- b) Any person licensed to judge agility in UKC or any other organization.
- c) Any agility instructor, regardless of the person's status as an amateur or professional.
- d) Any handler other than the owner or an eligible member of the owner's immediate family.
- e) Any dog that has earned a United Agility I title. Once UKC has notified the owner of a dog that the dog has earned a UAGI title, that dog must no longer compete in this section.

AGI-B ~ Open to all eligible dogs and handlers.

AGII-A ~ Eligible Competitors

- a) Open to dogs that have not earned a UKC UAGI title.

AGII-A ~ Ineligible Competitors: The following are ineligible to compete in AGII-A

- a) Any licensed or professional dog trainer.
- b) Any person licensed to judge agility in UKC or any other organization.
- c) Any agility instructor, regardless of the person's status as an amateur or professional.
- d) Any handler other than the owner or an eligible member of the owner's immediate family.
- e) Any dog that has earned a United Agility II title. Once UKC has notified the owner of a dog that the dog has earned a UAGII title, that dog must no longer compete in this section.

AGII-B ~ Open to all eligible dogs and handlers.

AGIII ~ Open *only* to dogs that have earned their UACH or higher.

## DIVISIONS

### **Size Division 1**

Hurdle heights = 8 inches ~ for dogs with shoulder heights up to and including 14 inches.

Crawl Space:

- 8 inches ~ when depth of chest is up to and including 7 inches
- 12 inches ~ when depth of chest is over 7 inches, and up to and including 10 inches.

### **Size Division 2**

Hurdle heights = 14 inches ~ for dogs with shoulder heights over 14 inches up to, and including, 20 inches.

Crawl Space:

- 12 inches ~ when depth of chest is over 7 inches, and up to and including 10 inches.
- 16 inches ~ when depth of chest is over 10 inches, and up to and including 14 inches.

### **Size Division 3**

Hurdle heights = 20 inches ~ for dogs with shoulder heights of over 20 inches.

Crawl Space:

- 16 inches ~ when depth of chest is over 10 inches, and up to and including 14 inches.
- 20 inches ~ when depth of chest is over 14 inches.

## **TITLES**

### **Agility I Title (UAGI)**

Title is earned by: receiving three (3) qualifying scores at three (3) different U.K.C. Licensed Agility Trials. A qualifying score requires the successful completion of all obstacles and a score of 170 or more. All three qualifying scores may be obtained under the same Judge.

Dogs may continue to be entered in this Class after having completed the requirements for the UAGI title.

### **Agility II Title (UAGII)**

Title is earned by: receiving three (3) qualifying scores at three (3) different U.K.C. Licensed Agility Trials. A qualifying score requires the successful completion of all obstacles and a score of 170 or more. All three qualifying scores may be obtained under the same Judge.

Dogs may continue to be entered in this Class after having completed the requirements for the UAGII title.

Entry in the Agility II class is open to dogs with or without the Agility I title. Dogs that have been pre-entered in a trial but have completed requirements for the UAGI title at a trial since pre-entering, the entry of that dog may be moved to the Agility II Class at the discretion of the trial giving club. Although a dog may be entered in the Agility II Class before having completed the requirements for the Agility I Class, the Agility II title (UAGII) is not awarded until the dog has completed the requirements for the Agility I title (UAGI).

### **Agility Champion Title (UACH)**

Title is earned by: (A) accumulation of 100 points awarded for scores of 196 or more in the Agility I and Agility II Classes; (B) at least 40 of the 100 required points must be obtained from the Agility II Class.

The following schedule is used in the awarding of U-ACH points:

Score of 200 = 10 UACH points

Score of 199 = 6 UACH points

Score of 198 = 4 UACH points

Score of 197 = 2 UACH points

Score of 196 = 1 UACH points

Accumulation of points toward the title of United Agility Champion (UACH) may begin at the next trial following the completion of the requirements of the UAGI and UAGII titles. Scores obtained in the Agility I class at the same trial at which a dog obtained its third Agility II qualifying score, may not be used toward the accumulation of UACH points.

Dogs may continue to be entered in the Agility I and/or Agility II Classes after having completed the requirements for the UACH title.

The number of UACH points awarded for a performance are based solely on the score obtained for that performance. UACH points are not awarded on the basis of placements obtained in the Agility I and Agility II classes, or the number of participants at trials.

### **Agility Champion Excellent Title (UACHX)**

The Agility III class is only open to dogs that have earned their UACH. Accumulation of qualifying scores toward the title of Agility Champion Excellent (UACHX) may begin at the next trial following the completion of the required UACH degree.

Title is earned by: receiving five (5) qualifying scores in the Agility III class at five (5) different U.K.C. Licensed Agility Trials. A qualifying score in Agility III requires the successful completion of all obstacles and a score of 196 or more. Three qualifying scores may be obtained under the same Judge.

Dogs may continue to be entered in this class after having completed the requirements for the UACHX title.

**United Grand Agility Champion Title (UGRACH).**

Any dog that has earned a UACHX title may earn legs toward the title of United Grand Agility Champion (UGRACH) beginning at the next trial following the completion of the requirements of the United Agility Champion Excellent (UACHX) title.

To earn this title a dog must:

- a) Combined wins. At five different UKC Licensed agility trials, earn a qualifying score in each of the AGI-B, AGII-B and AGIII classes in the same trial with a combined score of 588 points or higher.
- b) Judge Requirements. Two of the combined wins must be under at least two different Judges.
